Sublimation Printer Policy

Purpose

Rochester Public Library District desires to offer community access to new and emerging technologies such as Sublimation Printing to inspire a new interest in design and help the community to bring their creations to life. This policy establishes how and under what circumstances the public may use the Library's Sublimation Printer.

Patrons may use the sublimation printer to print reversed designs of up to 8.5"x11" on sublimation paper, then use our Cricut Heat Press to transfer those designs to, t-shirts, plastic, wood and more.

What You Need

Sublimation printing works best with fabrics that are at least 40% polyester material. Specially prepared "sublimation blanks" for items such as keychains, phone cases, mousepads, and more can also be purchased at many local and online retailers.

Sublimation 8.5" x 11" paper can be purchased from the circulation desk for \$1.50 per page.
