Cricut Explore Air 2 Policy

The Cricut is an electronic cutting and drawing machine. Designs created on your computer can be cut or drawn into material such as paper, cardstock, and vinyl. The Cricut can be used to make signs, custom t-shirts, labels, greeting cards and stickers.

Patrons can create their own designs from the Cricut Design Space Link on a library computer.

Applying Your Design

Depending on what you are making and the material you are using, the application process varies. For vinyl designs that you will be applying to hard surfaces, you will need transfer tape. For iron-on materials, you will need to reverse your design in Design Space (which is easy to do after you've clicked the Make It button).
