#### What is streaming music?



- Streaming music services allow you to listen to music in real time by delivering a continuous "stream" of data to your device
- Unlike regular downloads (where you have to download the entire file before you can use it), streaming services let you start listening to a song before it's completely downloaded
- When you stream a song or album, the data for that song does not stay on your device once you've finished using it
- There are LOTS of streaming music services to choose from!

#### Streaming Music Requirements

In general, to use streaming music services you will need:

- A computer and/or mobile device (smartphone or tablet) that you can install the streaming music app on
- Internet access/mobile data → should be fast enough to stream music without having to buffer or pause a lot (recommended speed is 1.5 megabits per second or higher)
- If you want to use a **premium** version of a streaming service, you will need to pay for a premium membership

## Streaming Music Services: Pandora





<ul> <li>Pandora is a streaming radio service → you can't choose specific songs you want to listen to, but instead can find songs and/or artists that are similar to your favorites</li> <li>Good way to discover new music that matches your tastes</li> </ul>	• 1,000,000 + songs	<ul> <li>Can skip songs you do not like, but are limited to 6 skips a station and 30 skips in a 24 hour period</li> <li>Music cannot be downloaded</li> <li>Free version has ads</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Free version         can be used         on mobile         devices and         web app         (Xbox, Roku,         etc)</li> <li>Desktop app         can be used         with a         Pandora One         subcription</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>"Pandora One" is premium, ad-free version</li> <li>Comes with desktop app</li> <li>Allows for more daily skips</li> <li>Cost: \$4.99/month</li> </ul>

# Streaming Music Services: **Spotify**

<ul> <li>You can choose the songs you want to play, when you want to play them!</li> <li>Can also listen to premade playlists or add music to personal playlists with unlimited skips</li> <li>Good for streaming music you already know and love</li> </ul>	• About 30 million songs	<ul> <li>Free version includes ads, and limits how much you can listen to individual songs and playlists</li> </ul>	Mobile, web, and desktop apps are available to all users	<ul> <li>Spotify Premium lets you download songs and listen to them offline</li> <li>Is also ad-free</li> <li>Cost: \$1.00 for first 3 months and then \$9.99/month with a 50% family discount</li> </ul>

# Streaming Music Services: Apple Music (iTunes)



What It Is, and What It's Good For	Music Library Size	Limitations	What Can You Install It On?	Premium Version Cost & Features
<ul> <li>Similar to Spotify → lets you listen to full albums and individual songs, sometimes on the same day that the album is released</li> <li>Some artists sometimes release "exclusive" content through Apple (extra songs, early music releases)</li> </ul>	About 30 million songs	<ul> <li>Free version only lets you listen to a few stations and to music you already have purchased or ripped to your device</li> </ul>	Currently can only install on iOS or on a Mac or PC	<ul> <li>Unlimited access to the full iTunes catalog</li> <li>Can save music to your device for offline listening</li> <li>Cost: First 3 months are free, then \$9.99/month (\$14.99/month with family sharing)</li> </ul>

## Streaming Music Services: Slacker Radio



What It Is, and What It's Good For	Music Library Size	Limitations	What Can You Install It On?	Premium Version Cost & Features
<ul> <li>Similar to Pandora → Lets you listen to stations based on genre or artist</li> <li>Can create customized stations that match your music tastes and share them with other users</li> </ul>	• 10 million songs	<ul> <li>Free version has ads and limits how much you can skip songs</li> <li>Music is not downloadable (in free version)</li> </ul>	Mobile devices and desktop computers	<ul> <li>Unlimited skips, can also download music to your device for offline listening</li> <li>Allows you to listen to specific, individual songs (rather than just stations generated around that song)</li> <li>Cost: \$3.99/month</li> </ul>

### Installing a Streaming Music Service

Once you've decided what service you want to use, follow these steps to install it!

#### **ON A MOBILE DEVICE:**

- 1. Go to the **App Store** (for iOS devices) or the **Google Play** store (for Android)
- 2. Search for the music app you want to install, then click the **Install** or **Download** buttons
- 3. Open the app when it's finished installing
- 4. Sign-up for an account (if you haven't done so already)
- Start listening to your music!

#### ON A DESKTOP COMPUTER:

- 1. Go to the website for the service you want to use spotify.com
  pandora.com
  slacker.com
  apple.com/music
- Sign-up for an account (if you haven't done so already)
- If the service has a web app, you should be able to start listening immediately
- 4. Some services (like Apple Music) do NOT offer web apps, so you will need to download and install the desktop app to your computer (iTunes)

### Setting Up a Premium Membership

- Most streaming music services allow you to do a trial run of their premium version before actually subscribing
- To set up your trial, you can go to the service website and follow the steps for setting up a premium membership (there will usually be a button that sets "Get Premium" or "Start Premium Trial")
- Some services also let you set up premium membership from inside the app itself
- Be sure to read the terms and conditions before you start a premium trial so that you know how to cancel it if you don't want to continue when the trial ends
